EXPRESSION OF INTEREST FOR SHORTLISTING SUPPLIERS OF CATTLE EAR TAGS

PREAMBLE

The Directorate of Veterinary Services seeks to shortlist suppliers for cattle eartags for the official livestock identification and traceability system. The Directorate of Veterinary Services is therefore inviting those interested in being short listed for the opportunity to supply cattle eartags to submit an expression of interest.

BACKGROUND

The Namibian cattle identification, registration and traceability system involves individual identification animals using single eartags from the time they leave their farm of origin. With effect from August 2008 all cattle on a farm or other animal holding will be required to be individually identified by means of two approved ear tags from the age of six months and registered onto a central database.

PROCESS

The Directorate of Veterinary Services shall shortlist qualifying suppliers from the expressions of interest received. Those short listed will be invited by the Meat Board of Namibia to submit full tender proposals for the supply of eartags.

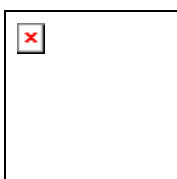
GUIDE DOCUMENT
