TO: All Agents, Abattoirs, Butchers, Producers, Speculators, Farmer's Associations, Extension Offices and all other persons or institutions paying or collecting Meat Board of Namibia levies in terms of the Meat Industry Act, 1981 (Act no. 12 of 1981).

SUBJECT: NEW MEAT BOARD OF NAMIBIA STANDARD LEVIES FOR 2020/2021

You are hereby notified that the Meat Board of Namibia standard values for determining Meat Board of Namibia levies are updated annually as per Government Notice no. 139/2012. Actual values achieved during the previous calendar year, in this case 2018, are the new standard values for implementation 1 April 2020 to 31 March 2021 and are as follows:

STANDARD VALUES	N\$/head Applicable as from 1 April 2020
Cattle: Live Prices	5,708
Sheep: Live/Slaughter Prices	954
Goat: Live/Slaughter Prices	856
Cattle: Slaughter Prices	10,510
Pig: Live/Slaughter Prices	1,657

- The standard values are only applicable when actual values of transactions cannot be verified by the MBN, such as during the export of livestock, out of hand transactions and slaughtering at C-class abattoirs.
- Actual values are applicable when transactions such as during slaughter at export abattoirs, auctions and permit days are verifiable.
- MBN levies payable are calculated as percentages of the actual and standard values with the percentages being:
Slaughter – 0.7%
Auction/Out of Hand – 0.6%
Export of livestock – 1.0%
Import of livestock and Meat and Meat products – 0.8%
